Run for the Cure® Foundation is a non-profit organization (NPO) that funds breast cancer education and awareness programs throughout Japan. The Foundation donates mammography equipment to rural screening centers, trains technicians, and funds screenings for women in medically underserved areas.

## About Run for the Cure® Foundation

Our mission is to eradicate breast cancer in Japan as a life-threatening disease through education, timely screening, and treatment.

As of 2011, 6 mammography machines (¥6.3 million each) have been donated around Japan. The Foundation was able to provide free screening to 100 people per donated mammography machine, also assisting funding for 800 additional screenings. The Foundation has provided the funds to allow for about 7,000 women in medically underserved areas to undergo screenings.

The Foundation publishes and distributes "PiNK," a breast cancer awareness magazine for Japanese women published quarterly (circulation: 20,000 copies), bringing readers the latest information on drug therapy and treatment, surgical procedures, nutrition tips, exercise, and personal stories by survivors.

## About the Mustang Association

The Mustangs are a group of United States Naval Officers who represent NAF Atsugi and Carrier Air Wing Five. Mustangs are former enlisted Sailors who earned their commission to LDO or CWO by advancing through the ranks. They are technical and managerial experts in their specific fields of work. The Mustangs support the community through various fund-raising projects, as well as mentor young Sailors desiring to become future Mustangs.

## The Event

This year's "A Day at Atsugi" is being co-organized by the Atsugi Mustangs and Santa Fe Relocation Services on behalf of Run for the Cure® Foundation.
